North Somerset Boundary Walk 7 – Kingston Seymour to Sand Point.

Sunday 17th September – Hard – 15 miles. 7 hours.

King Alfred's Tower – Long Knoll – White Sheet Down/Stourhead.

Follows the McMillan Way along the wooded ridge before crossing the high chalk downlands of Long Knoll and White Sheet Down (beware low flying gliders). Return via Stourhead (tea rooms) and up through the forest.
